## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Eligible employees in Hong Kong (i.e. persons legally residing in Hong Kong who are free to be employed or work without conditions, including Hong Kong permanent residents and new arrivals); and
- 2. Registered general workers: and
- 3. At least 1 year relevant working experience (verified by the training bodies); and
- For those who have not registered as registered semi-skilled workers or registered skilled workers of any trade under Construction Workers Registration Ordinance; and
- Has not obtained the intermediate trade test certificate or trade test certificate qualification; and
- Has not taken the courses offered or funded by the CIC and HKIC over one year prior to application.
